Within the agricultural activities, Mon district has the highest percentage of employees with 18.81 percent followed by Kohima district (**Table 4.3**), whereas it recorded nil establishment and employment in Kiphire district. Employment was recorded highest in the rural areas in agricultural activity with almost all the districts recording above 80.00 percent except Mokokchung which showed 55.77 percent in rural areas and 44.33 percent in urban areas. It also shows that Mon districts has the highest number of employees engaged in forestry and logging with 384 persons both rural and urban combined.

Figure 4.3: District wise Percentage Distribution of Employment in Agricultural Activity

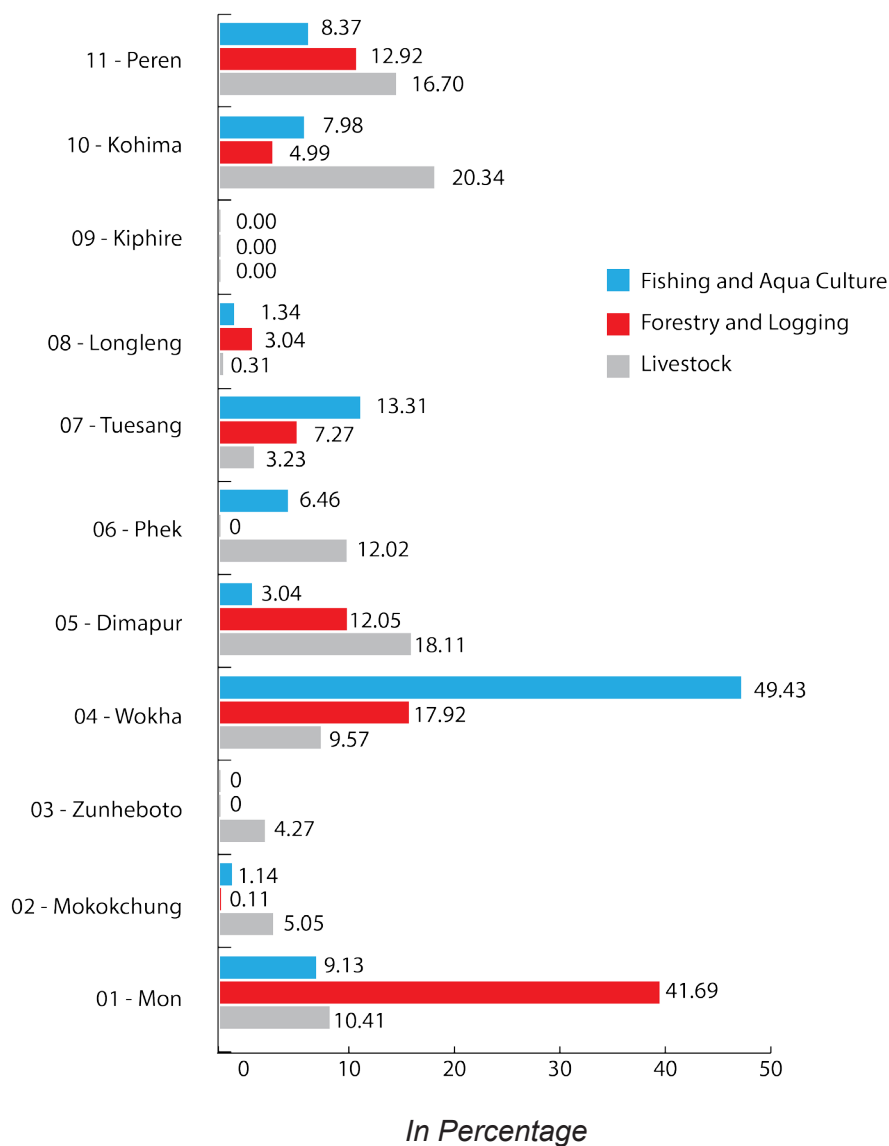
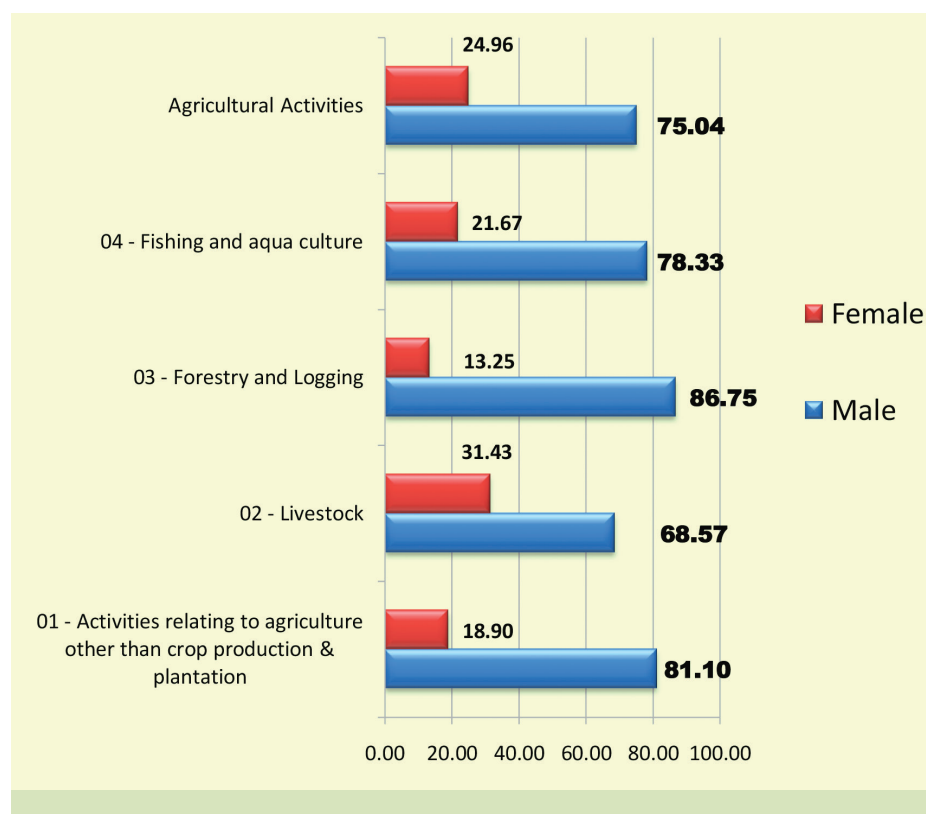

Gender wise employment in establishment both hired and non-hired is depicted in the **figure 4.4**. It shows that the percentage of employment in the agricultural activities is dominated by male with 75.05 percent and female with 24.96 percent. Comparatively, the share of female employment is more in the livestock sector with 31.43 percent as against 68.57 for male. In the other activities employment of male is above 70.00 percent and female's share is less than 30 Percent.

The district wise break up of detail employment in agricultural activities is given in **table no 4.5**. Out of 3233 persons employed the number of male employees was 2426 and female employees was 807 across various activities.

CHAPTER - V

NON-AGRICULTURAL ESTABLISHMENT OTHER THAN SERVICE

NON-AGRICULTURAL ESTABLISHMENT

Establishments engaged in activities other than agriculture (like crop production & plantation, growing of tea, coffee, rubber, tobacco etc.) are termed as non-agricultural establishments; i.e. activities which do not fall in the broad activity codes 01 to 04 and are covered under code 05 to 23. This chapter relates to non-agricultural activity other than services sector. It will include only those activity covered under code 5 to 9 which are Mining & Quarrying, Manufacturing, Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply, Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities and Construction.

A total of 11131 number of establishments was recorded with 2475 in the urban areas and 8656 in the rural areas. Within these activities bulk of the establishments comes from the Manufacturing Activity with 10004 establishments followed by Mining and Quarrying with 693 units and 333 units from the construction activity.

Figure 5.1: Percentage Distribution of Non-Agricultural Establishment other than Service Activity by Location.

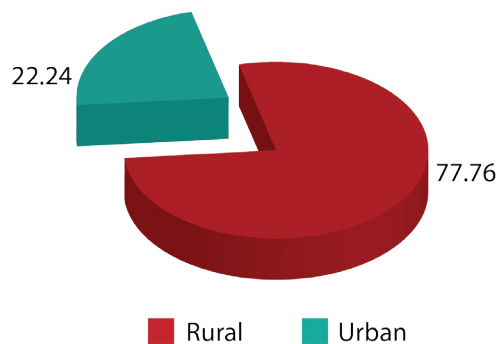


Table 5.1 gives the detail number of establishments under non-agricultural activity other than service sector in the State. The number of own account establishment has the highest share in total establishment recorded under this activity with 76.69 percent and 23.31 percent of the establishments had at least one hired worker.

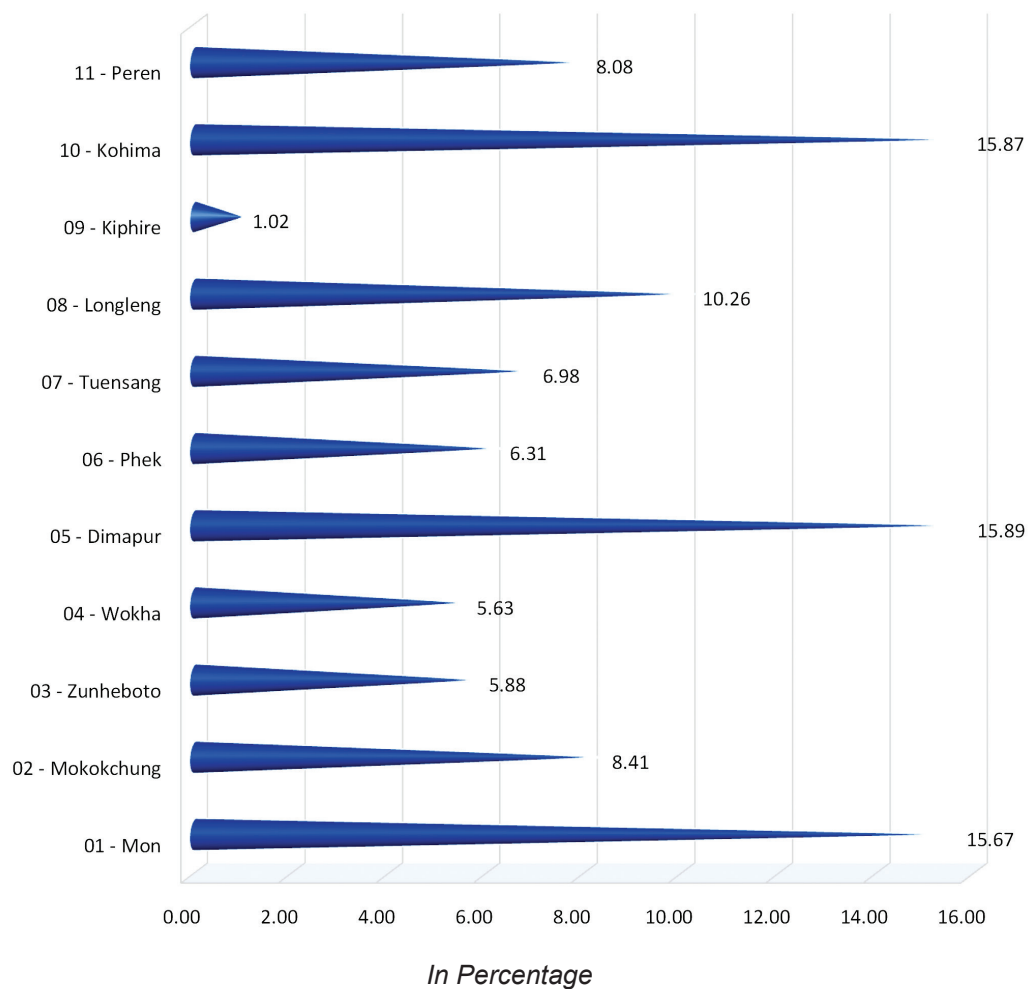

The district wise number of non-agricultural establishment is given in **table 5.2**. Out of the total 11131 number of non agricultural activity units Dimapur district has the highest with 1769 units Kohima had 1767 units followed by Mon with 1744. The district with the least units of non-agricultural activity unit was recorded from Kiphire district with 114 units. Across the districts it emerges that manufacturing activity is the dominant activity. Among the broad activity, water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities has the least share of establishments with only 40 units spread across the eleven districts in the State.

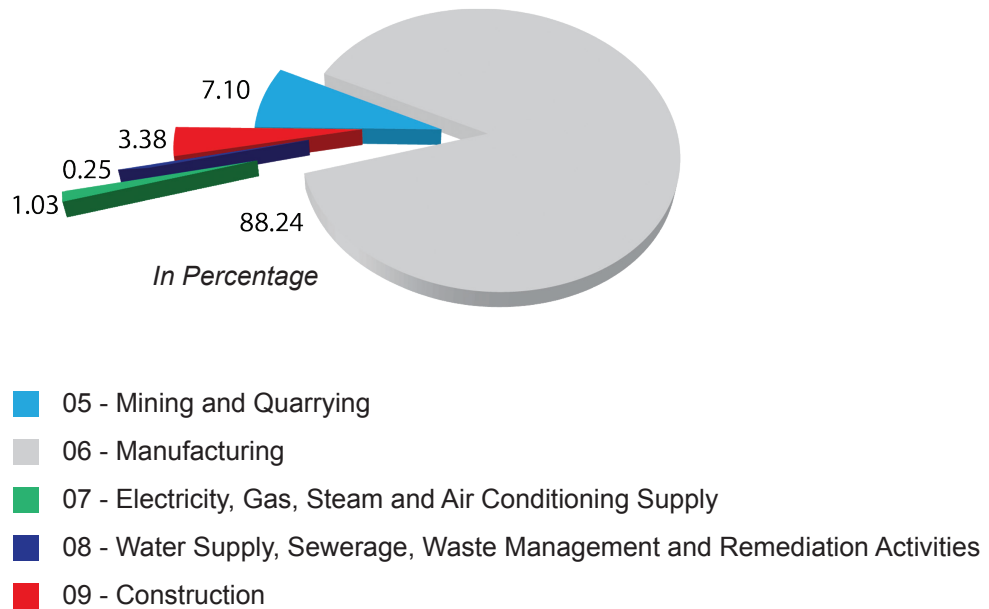

In terms of non agricultural units other than service Kiphire has the least share with 1.02 percent whereas Dimapur district 15.89 percent has the highest share.

In this sector, the 82.24 percent of person are employed in the manufacturing activity and is 0.25 percent are employed in water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities. Within the activity the share of employment in the sub sectors were 7.10 percent, 3.38 percent and 1.03 percent in mining and quarrying, construction and electricity gas, steam and air conditioning respectively.

The detailed break-up of employment in various non-agricultural activity other than service is given **Table 5.3**. Rural area recorded employment of 89.16 percent of the persons engaged in non agricultural activity other than service while urban areas reported employment of 85.64 percent.
