EDUCATION AND LITERACY

EDUCATION AND LITERACY

Education is the single most important means for individual to improve personal endowments, build capability levels, overcome constraints and in the process enlarge their available set of opportunities and choices for a sustained improvement. Considering the importance of education, India has enacted 'Right to Education' to ensure free and compulsory Education for children in the age group 6-14 years.

Literacy Rate

- As per Census 2011, the literacy rate of Nagaland was 79.55% and the literacy rate for females and males were 76.11% and 82.75% respectively. During the last decade, the literacy rate was 66.6% with female literacy rate of 61.5 % and male literacy rate of 71.2%. The female literacy rate has increased by 14.61 % over the last 10 years.
- Amongst the district, Mokokchung has the highest literacy rate of 91.6 % with male literacy rate of 92.2 % and female literacy rate of 91 %. The lowest literacy rate at 57% was recorded in Mon district (Male: 60.9%, Female: 52.6%).
- The gap in literacy rates of males and females is low in the district of Mokokchung, Zunheboto and Longleng and high in the district of Phek, Kiphire and Peren.

Enrolment Statistics

- During 2017 -18, the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in Schools at Primary level for females and males are 103.67 and 102.94 respectively, GER at middle class for females = 72.75 and males = 70.32, GER at secondary for females = 64.32 and males = 60.94 and at higher secondary level, GER for females = 30.97 and males = 28.05.
- The Net Enrolment Ratio (NER) in Schools at Primary level during 2017-18 for females and males are 80.56 and 80.18 respectively, GER at Upper primary class for females = 52.93 and males = 50.50, GER at secondary for females = 38.18 and males = 35.14 and at higher secondary level, GER for females = 18.49 and males = 13.86.
- The Gender Parity Index for Government Teachers in Nagaland is 0.89 for primary level, 0.87 for upper primary and 0.87 for secondary level (report 2017-18).

Drop-out Rates

- As per Directorate of School Education, drop-out rates for boys and girls in the primary level during the year 2017-18 was 4.46 and 3.81 respectively, 3.46 and 3.24 in the middle level and 4.12 and 3.62 in the elementary level. The drop out level is more or less equal for both the genders. District of Kiphire has the highest number of drop outs.
- During the Year 2015-16, number of Female Teachers per 100 Male Teachers in Primary, Middle and Secondary levels stands at 95,68 and 64 respectively.
